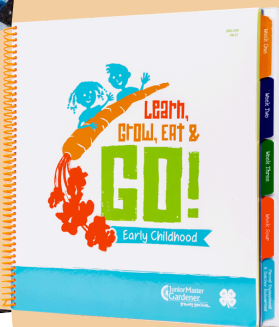

The easy-to-follow program combines hands-on lessons (learn), garden activities (grow), opportunities to taste fresh vegetables (eat), and physical activity breaks (go)

Learn, Grow, Eat & GO! (LGEG) is a research-based, evidence-based curriculum project of the International Junior Master Gardener® Program. This is a 20-lesson curriculum extension that coordinates with Texas TEKS for 3rd – 5th grade students.
